Cooke started Terrapin Tours seven years ago as part of her passion for travel and desire to share the fun, laughter, excitement, and adventure of going to new places and making new friends. From offering only a handful of tours and destinations in its first year, to now over 20 tours annually, Terrapin Tours has experienced tremendous growth and success and is overjoyed to be able to give back to local communities.

“But we’re not done yet!” added Cooke. In the coming year, Terrapin Tours will award another round of scholarships that will enable additional New Hampshire students to experience the benefits of travel; plus they will continue to collect un-used toiletries while on tours and plan to donate even more than last year. In addition to the toiletry donations, they will be highlighting a specific need or cause during the months in which they travel. Travelers will then have the opportunity to donate and support the cause while participating in their trip. “Not only is this a great way for Terrapin Tours to continue giving back” added Cooke, “but it’s a way for our travelers to get involved as well – something I know many of them find incredibly rewarding and fulfilling”.
